River Gauge Boards

Locally to us there are 3 boards that show the heights of water on the brooks.

East Hanney Iron Bridge

The one by the Iron Bridge has been installed by us and is an old Imperial Gauge board given to us by the EA. It is marked in feet and inches with the thickness of a black mark or the white space equal to one inch.





Botney Bridge.

At Botney Bridge there is a metric gauge board installed by the EA. It has a unique identification number, in this case. 17 0 06. The gauge board is measured in metres above sea Level. The top mark is 63m. The thickness of the black marks are 1cm.





Gallows Bridge

At Gallows Bridge there is another gauge board installed by the EA. This has lost the top identification mark.
