IRON BRIDGE BUND: PLANTING LIST

Set out below is a list of what we were planting this morning, (18 Jan 2025) in case you want to go away and look them up.:

Juncus effusus, Soft Rush

Grows in tufts up to 150cm tall, found in damp, often grassy, places especially in badly drained, overgrazed fields.

Carex pendula, Pendulous Sedge

Grows in substantial clumps up to 180cm tall with drooping, grass like, flowers. Frequent in woods on heavy soils and by shady streams.

Geum.

Could be *Geum urbanum*, **Wood Avens** up to 60cm tall common in woodlands, hedgerows and scrub on less acid soils or, perhaps more likely, *Geum rivale*, **Water Avens** growing in wet meadows, marshes and moist woods.

Lycopus europaeus, Gypsywort.

Grows 30 -100 cm tall, common on stream banks and in ditches and fens.

Filipendula ulmaria, Meadowsweet.

Grows up to 120cm tall with white feathery flowers, in meadows, wet woods and roadside ditches. Freshly broken or cut stems smell strongly, sometimes described as 'like Germoline'.

Lythrum salicaria, Purple-loosestrife

Grows up to 120cm tall and produces spectacular spikes of purple flowers. By rivers, lakes, swamps and fens.
